

# Directions To Sabattis

- ❖ **Take Rt. 287 North towards Mahwah (approx 30 miles North of Rt 24), all the way to the NY Thruway (I-87) Northbound.**
- ❖ **Follow Rt. I-87N for about 118 miles. Take Exit #24 marked “I-87 N/I-90 E” (at mile marker 148) towards Albany/Montreal, and proceed 1 mile.**  
Don't be confused that you are taking an exit named the same as the road you are on.
- ❖ **After the toll, take I-87 N (Exit 1N) towards Albany Int'l Airport/Montreal, and proceed for the next 60 miles.**  
You may know this route as the “North Way”, but it is not currently marked as such.

- ❖ **Go 59.5 miles, and take the Warrensburg exit #23.** (just past Lake George). This is 179 miles since you first started on I-87 at the start of NY. The camp is approximately 75 miles from this exit.



*Zero your trip odometer here, as subsequent (green) mileages will be given from this point.*

Also, the GPS coordinates of this exit are  $43^{\circ} 29' 2.5''$  N,  $73^{\circ} 45' 14.5''$  W.

- ❖ **Proceed left crossing I-87,** (on Diamond Point Road) for about 300 yards, and you will come to a “T” intersection, shown here:



**Bear right onto 9 North, following the sign “To 28”** as seen in this close-up:



There is a Mobil gas station, and a McDonald's (nice meeting point) immediately on your right hand side.



❖ **After about 4.6 miles, you must turn left to get on Rt. 28** (28 and 9 split here).  
**GPS 43° 32' 1" N, 73° 47' 44" W ; Mile 4.6.**  
**Proceed in the direction of North Creek:**

- Once on 28, you'll proceed about 45 miles, winding along beside a canoeing river
- N. Creek & Hudson River Raft Co purple busses: **mile 19.**
- Do **not** turn right at 28N the first time you see it -- at **43° 41' 50" N, 73° 59' 18" W ; mile 20.6.**
- Go through North River (**mile 25**), Indian Lake (**mile 35**)
- **Rt 30 merges into 28 from the south (mile 38); then you are on both 28/30.**
- Lake Durant (**mile 47.5**), Blue Mtn Lake (**mile 48.5**)



❖ **Stay on Rt. 28/30 until you end at a "T" intersection in Blue Mt. Lake; turn right onto Rt. 30 North. Mile 49.2.**

- The 'Ol Station' deli/ice cream is on your left
- Note that 30 North is also 28N East for a distance, but that 28 West goes left here.
- **Coordinates 43° 51' 26" N, 74° 25' 52" W**



❖ **Take Rt. 30 for about 7.5 miles (through Blue Mt. Lake) , then bear right (towards Long Lake - mile 56.6) and go another 3 miles, until you see Hoss' Store (mile 59.8).**

❖ **In Long Lake, you must turn left at Hoss' (mile 59.8) to stay on Route 30 North.** At this point, you leave Route 28N which proceeds ahead straight (Eastward).



Hoss' and this signpost are at **43° 58' 7" N, 74° 25' 8" W,**

**Within a half a mile, the road bears sharp left, to go over a causeway in Long Lake.**

❖ **Stay on Rt. 30 for about 7 more miles; then watch for Sabattis Road – (Mile 66.9) a left-hand turn at the top of a hill .** (as the road begins to curve to the right).



The sign is brown with gold lettering:



- ❖ **Proceed on this road for about 2 ½ miles.** The road will go to the right and Little Tupper Lake will appear on your left-hand side.

- ❖ Just to the other side of Little Tupper Lake's causeway, you will come to a 3-way intersection. **Mile 69.8**

**Turn to the left, keeping the lake on your left-hand side, and this sign to your right.**

This is still Sabattis Road; if you had continued going straight at this intersection you would loop back around onto Rt. 30 (a couple of miles up from where you originally got off...the road sign on Rt. 30 coming from the north reads "Sabattis Circle Road").

This signpost is located at **44° 3' 18" N, 74° 33' 40" W.**

*Last cell phone reception it right here.*



- ❖ As you drive along this road you will see signs for Whitney Park and other recreational areas. **After about 2 miles the road will turn from pavement to dirt/gravel (mile 71.9).**
- ❖ **Once the road turns to dirt/gravel you have 2.5 more miles to go until you get to the camp road.**

- ❖ **The entrance road for the camp is on the left-hand side as you crest a hill.**

When you pass the sign for Lake Lila Road (**mile 74.4, coordinates 44° 0' 10" N, 74° 45' 19" W**), Sabattis will be the next driveway on the left. There is a large, round camp sign pictured here. This camp road is the last driveway before a small bridge that crosses a lake. It is about **74.6 miles** from Route 87 to camp (1 hour and 45 minutes).



Note: If you use Mapquest or a similar online mapping tool, beware that many will not show the roads as you get close to camp. Google Earth and Google Maps show down to Sabattis Road. It reports the coordinates as **44° 3' 13" N, 74° 39' 28" W.**
