Dear Parent/Guardian,

Throughout the summer all staff members are given the opportunity to take time off from their assigned duties. There are standards that we must adhere to regarding the number of staff that must be in camp at any given time.

All staff who are under the age of eighteen must have written permission from a parent/guardian in order to leave camp at any time. BSA policy dictates that staff under the age of eighteen may only ride in a car driven by someone 18 years of age or older and one in which a seatbelt is provided for each passenger. The policy is strictly enforced.

Please read and sign this form if the staff member will be under eighteen years of age during any part of the summer. Here is a point to consider. *You may request that he/she call you to ask your permission, to tell you where he/she is going, etc.*
